SPELLING BEE

The Spelling Bee competition is an educational tool in which students are asked to spell words out loud, letter by letter. It aims to improve students' vocabulary, pronunciation, concentration and confidence when using English. This activity promotes learning in a fun and motivating way, while encouraging healthy competition and supporting the development of strong language skills.

The lists of words are based on content and vocabulary they have learned and seen in class and approximately 2 weeks before the competition, they are shared with students for them to practice at home. The words are also reviewed and practiced in class.

Our 2025 Spelling Bee competition was held November 13th, with students from 1st to 6th grade. Also, our students from 11th grade were part of the group of judges and organizers of the event, fulfilling the activity with teamwork, mutual support and respect.
